Mechanical Scrutiny

Please present your car for Mechanical Scrutiny in the Deerpark Industrial Estate, Oranmore, Co. Galway. Scrutiny will be open from 14.00hrs - 19.00hrs on Friday 4th February 2011. **A guide for scrutiny times will also be posted on www.galwayinternationalrally.com from Saturday 29th January 2011.**

Please leave adequate space free on both sides of the car for the door decals.

Decals must be on the car and you must have the first section of the Mechanical Scrutiny form completed before presenting the car for Mechanical Scrutiny.

Documentation Scrutiny will be in the Clayton Hotel, Ballybrit, Galway from 15.00hrs to 20.00hrs on Friday 4th February 2011.

Please note that Driver and Co-driver Competition Licences must be handed in at recce sign-on.

Ceremonial Start: Oranmore, Galway

Attendance at the Ceremonial Start is compulsory for cars and crews of competitors numbered 1 to 20 inclusive, and all the Historic Competitors. It will take place in Oranmore Village, Co. Galway on Friday 4th February at 20.00hrs.

The start will be in seeded competition number order and there will be a one minute intervals for all crews. Time cards will not be issued. Crew members must wear their approved racing suits. A Start Assembly Area will be established immediately before the Ceremonial Start. Competing cars must

be in the holding area before 19.30hrs. The holding area will open at 19.00 hrs.

Competitors Safety Briefing

It is compulsory for all competitors to attend the Competitors Safety Briefing. To this end, 10 competitors numbers will be drawn at random at the briefing, and any crew whose number is drawn, and who are not present (both crew members must be present), will incur a 2 minute penalty as per Appendix 25, 3.2, Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2011).

The briefing will be held at **9.30pm on Friday 4th February at the Clayton Hotel, Ballybrit, Galway.** A notice in relation to the Competitors Safety Briefing will also be posted on the official notice board and will be displayed on the LCD screens in reception.

Competitors Start Times

Competitors start times and other relevant information will be posted on the event notice boards in the reception area of the Clayton Hotel. The onus is upon the competitor to read the information provided. Your cooperation with this request is necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event.

Reconnaissance

Competitors are requested to sign on at the start of (each) day. Sign on for Reconnaissance will take place at the Clayton Hotel, Ballybrit, Galway from 8.30am to 12 noon on each of the four days allocated for Reconnaissance in accordance with Article 26.1.

Speed limit on stages for recce 50kph.

Please note there will be radar speed checks on the route - **DO NOT IGNORE.** Please respect local residents. Penalties will be applied.

REDUCE YOUR SPEED ON THE APPROACH TO SCHOOLS ON THE RALLY ROUTE

Due to the number of primary schools on the rally route it is very important that competitors pay attention to **reduce your speed signs** on the approach up to and after the schools - **THIS APPLIES PARTICULARLY ON THURSDAY 3RD & FRIDAY 4TH FEB FROM LOCATION 12 TO THE FINISH ON SS 3/6/9.**

Please drive carefully as Garda speed checks will also be in place.

Your attention is also drawn to the Bus Lane in Claregalway. Competitors are asked to refrain from driving in the Bus Lane any competitor found doing so will incur penalties.

Sunday Run

A Sunday Run will be available for crews who have retired from the event on Saturday 5th February. The crew must make application to Rally Office before 7.00pm on Saturday 5th February, when they will be advised of their due time for re-scrutiny. A crew permitted to restart shall not be eligible for any Overall, Class, Stage, Tarmac championship or Galway Motor Club Championship awards.

Competitors failing to present 2011 competition licences and IRDS / BRDS letter will not be allowed to start the event.
