FINAL INSTRUCTIONS NO 1

Thank you for your entry for the Mór Oil Galway Summer Rally 2009. **Your seeded number is on the website, www.galwaymotorclub.ie**

Please note if your assigned Car Number is greater than 142 in the Main Field greater than 10 in the Junior Rally and 10 in the Mini 50 Celebration Rally, you are a Reserve Entry and will be contacted by the entries secretary as soon as a vacancy arises.

Sign-on for recce is on Friday 28th August between 20.00 - 22.00 hrs or Saturday 29th August 08.00 - 12.00 hrs in the Raheen Woods Hotel Athenry (Rally HQ).

Pace note making is strictly from 08.30hrs - 17.00 hrs on Saturday 29th August.

We expect competitors to adhere to the maximum speed limit of 60kph during recce. Competitors are reminded that speed checks may be placed at random by the organisers and general patrols of the special stages will take place.

In relation to recce cars may we remind you that commercial vans i.e. Transit/Vito type vehicles cannot be used. Please ensure that recce stickers are displayed prominently on your vehicle prior to departure from the hotel car park. You are reminded that as per Appendix 29 Section 4.6.1 Reconnaissance is limited to a maximum of three passes per stage or any part thereof. The Organisers will have personnel in place at appropriate points along the route to police the rules of Recce.

Please present your car for Mechanical Scrutiny at the Q-Tech, IDA Commercial Park, Raheen, Athenry, Co. Galway. Mechanical Scrutiny will be open from 14.00hrs to 20.00hrs on Saturday 29th August 2009. Your due time for scrutiny will be posted on www.galwaymotorclub.ie from Friday 21st August 2009. Late penalties will apply at scrutiny and paper scrutiny. All cars must be in Parc Ferme and Competitors must have completed Paper Scrutiny 30(Thirty) minutes after leaving mechanical scrutiny. For every five minutes of lateness a two minute penalty will apply. Competitors who have not arrived at paper scrutiny within thirty minutes of their due time will be deemed to be a non-starter; this will result in one of the reserve list being confirmed in your place.

Paper Scrutiny is at the Raheen Woods Hotel and Parc Ferme is at the rear of the hotel.

Door Decals and Mechanical Scrutiny Forms will be available at the Mechanical Scrutiny area. Decals must be on the car and you must have the first section of the Mechanical Scrutiny form completed *before* presenting the car for Mechanical Scrutiny.

Documentation Scrutiny will be in the **Raheen Woods Hotel**, Athenry Galway from 14.00hrs to 20.30hrs on Saturday 29th August 2009.

All service vehicles must be in Service prior to 9am sharp on Sunday 30th August 2009 - there will be no exceptions. The service area will be open from 22.00hrs on Saturday 29th August to 00.30hrs on Sunday the 30th August; Main Field Service will be in the Trading Post, Headford. The Juniors' and Zero Cars' service is located in the Car Park of Campbell's Tavern, Headford. Time for Juniors' service crews and Zero Service crews to be in service is 9am sharp on Sunday 30th August 2009.

Ground Sheets are required in the service area and frequent inspections of the use of Ground sheets will be carried out during the event by the Service Area Manager.

Licences must be handed in at recce sign-on.

Competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that their competition Licences and IRDS are in order before the weekend of the event. Competitors failing to present current competition licences and IRDS letter will not be allowed to start the event - without exception.
