Rally Office is located in the Doonbeg Suite.

Rally Office will be open at 8.30a.m Saturday September 14<sup>th</sup>. Both driver and co-driver must produce current competition licences at recce sign on. Please ensure that the driver has current IRDS/BRDS in time for Recce Sign on Saturday morning and that it is listed on the Motorsport Ireland database. Remember no IRDS means no start

**Scrutiny** will take place at Autobody Garage in the Ennis Mart Complex from 14.00 hrs to 19.00 hrs on Saturday September 14<sup>th</sup>. No **scrutiny on Sunday morning**.

Paper scrutiny will take place in Rally Office (Doonbeg Suite in Hotel Woodstock) from 14.30 hrs to 20.00 hrs Saturday evening September  $14^{th}$ . Please note that paper scrutiny will close at 20.00 sharp.

Competitors must have their cars in Parc Ferme 20minutes after passing mechanical scrutiny.

**Parc Ferme and Trailer Park** is in the Ennis Mart Complex **V95 APF2**. Service will take place after SS3 & SS6 in Ennis Mart Complex.

The Management of Hotel Woodstock have asked us that absolutely no rally cars or service barges come to Hotel on Saturday as parking is very limited. Please bring your car to service/scrutiny. Marshals will be on duty in service/scrutiny all day from 8.00a.m.

All tyre trucks, merchandising trucks, parts trucks, hans and helmet hire will only be in the service/scrutiny area. Ennis Mart Complex is an ideal area for service/parc ferme and we would ask that you respect it and leave it clean and tidy. Please dispose of your rubbish in the bins provided. Competitors and Service crews are required to have all items belonging to them, including trailers, removed from the Service Area Complex by 8pm on Sunday

September 15<sup>th</sup> as the Mart Complex will be locked at this time and will not reopen until Monday morning.

All competition cars must use a large non-porous service mat. Penalty for non use of mat or for littering service area as per appendix 29, article 9:1:12 and 16 is 2 minutes.

# Service Area/Park Safety

In Motorsport Ireland's ongoing safety improvement plan and to ensure safety in all areas of our sport they now request the following to be in place for all service parks & areas where competition vehicles are been serviced. This requirement is mandatory and will be observed by the MI Officials.

No Smoking Signage to be displayed at the entrance point to the service park/area Smoking is Forbidden in the Service area

- Service Barges to be equipped with the following:
- 1 X 6kg ABC Dry Powder Fire Extinguisher (for each car serviced) , 1 X 6 Litre AFFFF(Foam)Fire Extinguisher (for each car serviced)

Extinguishers must be placed in a visible area, and have ease of access to

- Fire Extinguisher Board to be in place over the extinguishers
- Hot work is only undertaken by competent persons
- Service area manager undertakes checks on no smoking policy, signage and extinguishers

# RECCE

Pacenote making will take place on Saturday September 14th from 9.00a.m to 17.00p.m. Competitors please note when you are doing recce that the road from location 5 to location 12 on SS1/4/7 is part of a 10klm walking trail and is extremely popular with locals including children and tourists alike. Please slow down in this area as there would normally be very little traffic here. Please take extreme caution entering SS1/4/7 as there is a series of bends on approach to the entrance.

Competitors can also expect a lot of tourist traffic and cyclists on these roads so please respect other road users and travel with caution. RECCE stickers will be provided and must be placed on **the outside** of your windscreen, top left hand corner. Please do not put your RECCE sticker on your sun visor. Please ensure your competition number is on your RECCE sticker. Please have your road book ready for marshals located in the vicinity of the start and finish of the stages, to sign. **Please respect the residents and other road users during RECCE, as we depend on their co-operation to allow us rally**.

**Drivers briefing** will take place on Sunday morning September 15<sup>th</sup> at 8.00a.m in the Liscannor Suite at Hotel Woodstock. It is mandatory that all crews attend and a random role

call will take place. First car is away from Parc Ferme on Sunday morning September  $15^{th}$  at 9.40a.m.

As Hotel Woodstock is located in a very residential area, we are asking service crews not to block up entrances or to park in local housing estates to load rally cars on Sunday evening.

Final control will be located at the rear of Hotel Woodstock.
